Dear Friends and Family,

The picture above shows my daughters beaming over the birth of my dear friend Heather's daughter, Hadley Jane Lehr, in December 2013. Little did we know then, but Hadley would be taken from her loved ones far too soon. Hadley was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia (AML) in September 2015 and lost her battle with this terrible disease in August 2016. Throughout the course of Hadley's treatments at Peyton Manning Children's Hospital, Cincinnati Children's Medical Center and St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, the Lehrs' friends and family did all they could to help them and to make Hadley's days a little brighter. Make no mistake about it, Hadley was a ray of sunshine through it all, grinning and playing no matter where she was or what treatment or pain she was enduring.

This brings me to the reason for my letter. Below, Hadley is happily smiling for the camera with her friend, Annie Ruiz. **Annie Ruiz** is running for the **Leukemia Lymphoma Society's Student Visionary of the Year** and I have the honor of serving on Annie's Campaign Team to help her achieve this goal. Annie is a terrific young woman who truly wants to make a difference by helping those with blood cancers. Annie had to watch her little friend suffer from the AML that took her before she turned 3.
